Decoding Technology

Program Management Tools

Managing a child care program involves many complex tasks and daily challenges for administrators. However, with the right set of tech tools you can become a more effective and efficient manager which will enhance program quality and improve responses to your staff and the children, parents, families, and community you serve.

Tech Terms

- Software designed to handle specific child care administrative tasks such as tracking attendance of children and staff, billing, monitoring accounts receivable, managing child, family and personnel records, processing payroll, paying bills, and creating financial reports . . . just to name a few. These software packages are often available in modular format so that each program can select the features they want and need to manage their operations and finances efficiently.
- Application suite: A combination of different software such as word processing, spreadsheets, database management, desktop publishing, personal information management, and Web authoring bundled together. Programs in an integrated application suite look and act the same way, making it easy for users to transfer data from one application to another. Popular application suites include Microsoft Office, Corel WordPerfect Office, and Lotus SmartSuite.

Tech Tools

There are many types of software and the list of new programs grows daily. Keeping up with this can be an overwhelming chore for even the advanced technology professional. Nevertheless, there are some program management tools that are essential for all early childhood administrators. A child care management package brings together many of the features and functions you need, but you may find other applications and tech tools useful for specific functions. Whether you choose a child care management software package, an application suite, or a combination of the two you'll need:

- A word processing program for creating letters, memos, newsletters, fliers, forms, handbooks, proposals, and many other text-based documents. Popular word processing programs include Corel WordPerfect and Microsoft Word.
- A spreadsheets program for managing budgets, cash-flow forecasting, and completing other financial and analytical tasks. Popular spreadsheets programs include Lotus 1-2-3 and Microsoft Excel.
- A database management program for tracking child and family records, personnel records, and supplies and equipment inventory. Popular database management programs include Microsoft Access and FileMaker Pro.
- A desktop publishing program for creating newsletters and fliers.Popular desktop publishing programs include Adobe PageMaker and QuarkXPress.

- A Personal Information Manager (PIM) to organize contacts, tasks, dates, reminders, and a variety of other personal information. Popular PIM programs include Microsoft Outlook and Lotus Organizer.
- A Web authoring program to prepare word processing documents or desktop publishing files for your program Web page. Popular Web authoring programs include Macromedia Dreamweaver and Microsoft FrontPage.

Tech Tips

While the number of tools may seem endless, try selecting a few new programs to *test drive* occasionally. You may discover a more resourceful way of completing complex administrative tasks.

- Explore the range of functions and features available in a child care management packages and *demo* those that seem to best meet your needs.
- Use a desktop publishing program to layout and design your next newsletter instead of a standard word processing application.

- Put aside the paper and pencil and try managing your schedule, contacts, and "to do" lists with a PIM.
- Assemble your program's existing literature and promotional materials into an organized sequence of pages using a Web authoring program and publish to the Internet.
